Objectives

Student learning outcomes

At the end of this training, the trainees will be able to explain the IT and OT ecosystem of a major international airport. The trainees will understand the business and operational objectives of Athens International Airport (AIA), and will get a focus on main duties of Training Centre and Security Operation Center (SOC) analyst. They will become familiar with the incident handling and escalation processes. Moreover, an insight of the AIA supervision strategy and tools will be given.
